

Twisted Horn Outfitters Booking Terms

Booking Terms:

All reservations are subject to approval and must be accompanied by the required 50% of total hunt deposit upon confirmation of a reservation request. The balance is due and payable in cash or equivalent within 30-days prior to the hunt if paying by check, cashier's check/money order, or PayPal. No rate reduction can be made if hunter fails to arrive on prearranged date, or leaves before the end of contract period. Every effort will be made to schedule your hunt on the dates you have chosen; however, Twisted Horn Outfitters reserves the right to adjust that schedule. Schedule adjustments may occur from but are not limited to: change of season dates or closures by the Agency, Land Owner, or public land closure due to fires, floods etc., and failure of hunter to pay balance of hunt fee by due. Your deposit will protect you from possible future price increases for a period to not exceed 3-years unless otherwise stated in your hunt certificate or special promotions.

Licensing Policy:

Elk – Deer – Bear – Cougar general tags are guaranteed issued to Twisted Horn Outfitters clients hunting within Washington State. Instructions will be given for obtaining licenses/tags on-line prior to arrival or "over-the counter" for clients arriving early enough to obtain.

Special Permits:

Applications for special elk and/or deer permits, or other special game, are the sole responsibility of the client. Twisted Horn Outfitters will offer suggestions for special drawings in our area and nearby units that correspond with the client's choice of weapon and hunt time-frame. There are no additional fees for clients that are successful in drawing a special permit. Most drawings are for those that would like to harvest a special game, or hunts in selective hunt game management units.

Refund Policy:

If your hunt needs to be canceled due to extreme weather, acts of God, land closures or other situations beyond our control, we will gladly reschedule for another date. You may also transfer your hunt in writing to another person without any problem, however, we do not offer cash refunds. Twisted Horn Outfitters is not responsible for other costs incurred other than specified here.

Injured Animal Policy:

As your outfitter it is our responsibility to put you into a good shooting situation so you are able to make a clean, ethical shot. Under most circumstances our clients will be accompanied by a guide and are expected to follow any instructions given to them in a shooting situation and we expect all of our clients to operate within their shooting ability. In the unfortunate event that an animal is wounded and we are not able to recover it, despite making every effort to do so, we may elect to end the clients hunt if we feel the animal has been wounded to the extent that it will not survive.

Please note that this is not a "blanket" policy and that the decision to continue or end your hunt will be based on our extensive experience and best judgment. We understand that this can create a very uncomfortable situation for all involved but we as hunters have a responsibility to the animals we hunt to operate within our abilities, only take high percentage shots, and make all efforts to recover an animal we have wounded. It is our goal for ALL of our clients to be successful, but it is your responsibility as a hunter to turn down shots that you know are outside of your ability or that you are not comfortable taking.

Cancellation Policy:

Deposits will normally be forfeited for cancellations of 90-days or less. It is nearly impossible to fill openings created by last minute cancellations. If we are able to fill your hunt, you may reschedule for a future date.

Liability/Photo Release:

By its nature hunting can be a strenuous activity requiring stamina and good conditioning and the use of weapons such as firearms and bows, which can produce injury. Driving to and from the hunting areas is done on sub-standard and sometimes unmaintained roads. The hunter recognizes all risks, which can arise during hunting and holds harmless, forgives and forever releases and waives any claims, which he/she may have with Twisted Horn Outfitters, employees of said company, volunteers, or others directly or indirectly involved with said company. From time to time in our modern society, disputes arise and the hunter agrees that Washington law shall govern this contract and the legal obligations of Twisted Horn Outfitters. The hunter also agrees that the district court of Clark County, WA, shall be the exclusive and sole venue for all suits that may arise out of any disputes concerning this contract and the services provided by Twisted Horn Outfitters. In the event a suit is filed, the prevailing party shall be entitled to attorney fees. Twisted Horn Outfitters will use its best knowledge, expertise, and efforts to provide outfitter/guide services safely and to the best of their ability. Twisted Horn Outfitters does not guarantee conditions beyond its control such as weather, interference from other hunters, availability of game, etc. and the hunter accepts these terms. Hunter authorizes Twisted Horn Outfitters to use any photos of him/her and any game animal that he/she harvests for promotional purposes.

Participant agreement – Acknowledgement of Risk – Release:

I certify that I am capable of participating in this activity. I assume full responsibility for myself, for bodily injury, death, and loss of personal property and expenses thereof, as a result of my participation. I agree to abide by all Washington State game and trespass laws, and understand that my violation of such are grounds for TWISTED HORN OUTFITTERS to terminate this contract without refund. I have read, understand, and by voluntarily signing this document accept the terms and conditions stated herein and acknowledge that this agreement shall be effective and binding upon me during the entire period of participation in the activity.
